On behalf of Sundby Sejlforening and myself I would like to give you a warm welcome to the Yngling Open World Championship 2023.

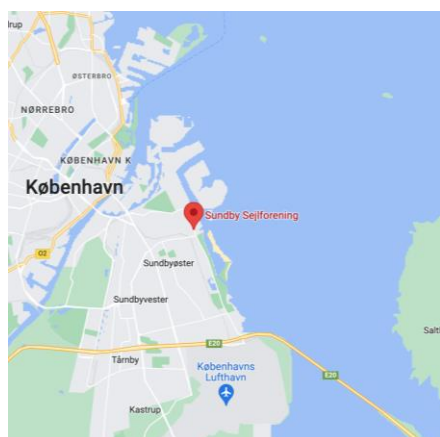

Depth is approx. 3 m.

GETTING TO COPENHAGEN

By Car

By Train

Copenhagen is part of the European rail network and therefore well connected to all parts of Europe.

By Plane

There are scheduled flights from all major European cities to Copenhagen Airport (CPH).

Intercontinental Flights to Copenhagen directly from New York, Chicago, Washington, San Francisco and Dubai or via Frankfurt (FRA), London, Amsterdam (AMS) etc.

Transport from CPH to Sundby Sejlforening via Metro or taxi (only approx. 5 km)

HISTORY OF SUNDBY SEJLFORENING (SSF)

Founded October 28th, 1923

Approx. 1200 members

The harbor is managed by Sundby Sejlforening.

SSF has a long history with the Int. Yngling Class both as organizer of Yngling race events such as Yngling WC 1983, Yngling Danish Championships and regional Yngling races as well SSF members participating in many Yngling WCs and ECs.

SSF was in 2022 nominated as 'Sports club of the year' in Denmark as 1 out of 3 clubs.

SSF has a reputation of well-organized race events both on the water and ashore.

In 2021 SSF organized Danish Championships for Melges 24 and for Nordic Folkboat.

In 2022 SSF organizes Danish Championships for BB10m and for Women's Team Sailing League in J/70.

SSF will in 2023 besides Yngling WC be organizing Women's Sailing Champions League (in September).

REGISTRATION

Notice of Race and registration is available via the manage2sail.com platform.

The Host Club is authorized to accept only entries that are certified by the National Yngling Association (or MNA if no NYA) of the skipper concerned.

A limited number of charter boats for overseas and youth teams will be made available through DYK. Information about how to reserve a charter boat, and pricing for it, will be published in the 'Notice of Race'. Boats will be available on a "first come, first reserved" basis.
